INSTRUCTIONS FOLLOWING MYRINGOTOMY AND TUBE INSERTION (BMT)

1. You may see a few drops of blood in the ear canal or on your pillow. If this persists for more than 24 hours please call the doctor at the office number below.
2. Tylenol or Motrin may be used for ear discomfort as needed.
3. **Keep all water out of your ears.** Earplugs may be purchased in the pharmacy under the name of Mack's Ear Plugs. Cotton placed in the ear may be covered with Vaseline to keep water out.
4. Children may return to their normal activities the day following surgery.
